### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's Degree in safety, health, EMS or related field (Master's preferred)
- 5 years safety experience within air medical transportation, EMS, or health care
- 3 years education/training experience in related field
- Education may be concurrent with experience
- Demonstrated effective oral, written and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work independently, exhibit sound judgment and decision-making
- Valid driver's license
- Must pass mandatory post-offer drug/physical agility and background screening tests
- Must weigh 220 pounds or less (rotor wing requirement)
